A TALENTED young fashion designer is looking forward to seeing her creation on the London Fashion Week catwalk.

Chadwell Heath teenager Egle Zepkinate, who studies fashion at City and Islington College, is one of 23 youngsters from London and Salford who have made it through to the final of the 2009 FAD Junior Awards, which is taking place at Vauxhall Fashion Scout on Tuesday 22 September.

Originally selected from 130 young designers, the 17-year-old had just five days at a FAD summer school, organised by creative charity FAD, to develop and construct her finished outfit for the London catwalk.

The winner of the awards will be revealed on the evening of the catwalk final, where Egle will be competing for the top prize – a placement in the industry.
