Fashion industry experts and professional designers were on hand last month to coach 50 Year 10 students from Greenwich schools, taking part in the Fashion Awareness Direct (FAD) summer workshop, hosted by Lewisham College.

During the week, professional fashion designers offered stepbystep advice to students on how to design, make and craft their own original garments.




Using the workshop's nautical design brief, the students' studied uniforms and prints from nearby Greenwich Maritime Museum for design inspiration, reflecting their ideas with illustrations and mood boards.

The course ended with a catwalk show displaying the students' work.

Stylist Daniela Buruty taught students how to style clothes for the catwalk, and MAC make-up artists demonstrated the correct techniques for applying make-up to catwalk models. Twelve students from the college's beauty school helped apply make-up for the show, ensuring all the students looked fabulous on the catwalk.

Lewisham College, head of fashion, Mary Kay said: "We were impressed with all the students they were really creative and produced some wonderful pieces."

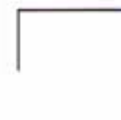
