

## Teens' work wins catwalk place

A GROUP of teenagers from Lewisham teenagers has earned the right to show off its own designs at prestigious London Fashion Week.

The five youngsters were chosen after coming through summer workshops put on by creative charity Fashion Awareness Direct (FAD).

Danielle Tunstall, 17, who goes to Prendergast Hilly Fields College in Adelaide Avenue, Brockley, is one of the lucky local designers.

She said: "I was absolutely shocked when I found out it would be used in fashion week - I didn't think it would get picked at all. "I did the workshops as experience more than anything else. Then, when they said my name and that I had been chosen, I couldn't believe it.

"I'm really happy to get this far - it's just nice to be showing my work.
