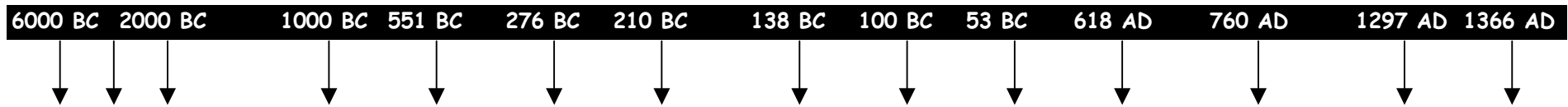


Urban Communication Timeline 7th FAD Competition



Art of calligraphy established by Yellow Emperor Cang Jie.

Characters made from 8 brushstrokes, these are as follows: dot, dash, horizontal stroke, perpendicular downstroke, the left, wavelike stroke, hook up stroke to the right and bend

Chinese brush strokes made from goat, wolf, rat or rabbit found on pottery

First use of mail system in Chou Dynasty

Confucius says "news of deeds travels faster than the mail"

Tea is called "Tu" and "Jai"

The calligraphy brush is invented by Meng Dian

Zhang Qian instigates the silk route

Virgil extolled Chinese silk as "more beautiful than fresh flower, more delicate than woven cobwebs"

Romans obtained silk from a tribe called "Seres"

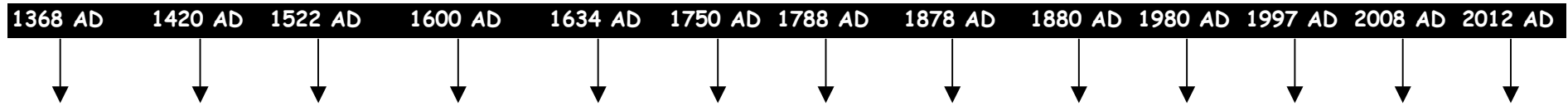
Tu Meng-Tang Dynasty develops 120 expressions to describe different styles of calligraphy and est. criteria for them

Lu Yu is respected as the sage of tea for his contribution to Chinese Tea Culture
